[Alianzas](#): Alianzas is central to services offered to immigrants, refugees, and asylum-seekers in the Phoenixville area. They help people who are not comfortable seeking help elsewhere.

[Phoenixville Liberation Center](#): they have been hosting ICE Out training sessions for people who feel moved to protest and/or record ICE activity in the Phoenixville area. They have also been central to organizing some of the rallies that have been held downtown recently.

[Kate's Casa](#): an immigrant-led organization that provides multiple kinds of support for the immigrant community in our area.

[Project Libertad](#): they provide services to newly-arrived immigrant children and youth in the greater Philadelphia area, including the Phoenixville area.

They are, right this very minute: Shutting down Critical Care and the Cancer Center, Eliminating higher-level inpatient surgery, Cutting a Med-Surg unit and the float team and Laying off 70 experienced direct-care nurses. The website [DEMOCRACY.IO](#) was created by the Electronic Frontier Foundation. The platform simplifies the process of contacting your members of Congress by providing a single interface to send messages.

5 Calls App: Choose an issue you care about and make calls in support of progressive issues. The list is updated regularly. If you don't see your issue on the list, please [reach out](#). Enter your location and they will figure out who you need to call. They'll provide you with a script and tell you who to call for your chosen issue, from Representatives and Senators to Governors and Attorney Generals.
