INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTER

1. TO VOTE YOU MUST COMPLETELY BLACKEN THE OVAL (●) TO THE LEFT OF YOUR CHOICE. An oval (●) blackened to the left of the name of any candidate indicates a vote for that candidate.

To cast a write-in vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, you must blacken the oval () to the left of the line provided, and write or print the name in the blank space provided for that purpose.

- 3. Use only black ink pen.
- 4. If you make a mistake DO NOT ERASE. Ask for a new ballot.
